Case #: 54 Month: March Year: 2015

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Clinical History: A 1-year-old, spayed female, Domestic Shorthair cat was presented for acute lethargy and labored breathing. Findings at the physical examination included icterus, enlarged liver and spleen, and a palpable mass in the central abdomen. Due to poor prognosis, the animal was euthanized.
